It's been an exciting season of growth at Owens House! We've made several updates to create a more welcoming, comfortable, and inspiring space for everyone we serve. Several of our rooms have been refreshed, resulting in a brighter and warmer atmosphere. The playroom used for play therapy has been revamped with a new layout and mural, making it an even more engaging and supportive environment for children. We're thrilled to share that we have broken ground on a brand-new sensory garden—an outdoor space designed to spark curiosity, promote mental health, and support sensory development. We can't wait to see it come to life in the months ahead!

How We Are Doing

Over the past year, Owens House hosted Rhythm & Brews, our annual fundraising event. During this event, we raised nearly \$14,000 in support of Child Abuse Prevention Month!

We were also chosen as the beneficiaries of the proceeds raised during the Lay Lake Boat Club's annual Poker Run in July. The event raised \$52,000 for Owens House!
